RoHS Statement

Directive 2011/65/EC including Delegated Directive (EU) 2015/863)

The Directive 2011/65/EU known as RoHS2 of 21st July 2011 and Commission Delegated Directive (EU) 2015/863 (RoHS3) of 31st March 2015 amending Annex II to Directive 2011/65/EU which defined that maximum concentration values of 10 restricted substances in Electrical and Electronic Equipment (EEE) supplied in the market to EU member states.

RoHS restricted substances and their maximum allowable concentration values by weight are below. The substances are not intentionally added to self-adhesive products and we have no reason to suspect that these substances are present in the self-adhesive label stock levels above the allowable concentrations.
